

EID Tag Reminders

Please Note: When you receive your tags, please match up the heard number on the tag to the herd number on the bull for application. Please feel free to contact our office with any questions.

You must have a USDA Premise ID on file with us in order to receive your EID tags.

Starting with 2010 Born Bulls, if a bull is registered in the birth year, the breeder may purchase an EID tag at the time of registration. The EID tag will be printed with the bull's brand number, then mailed straight to you. When registering animals online, EID tags may be ordered during the checkout process. When registering animals with the paper application, EID tags may be ordered by marking "Y" for each animal in the correct column on the application.

If an EID tag is requested from the ABBI office at the time of birth year registration for 2011 and beyond, age certification will *not* be required.

EID tags cost \$15 each + **shipping & handling**.

If an EID tag is not requested at the time of birth year registration, you have the following options:

- You may send in a tail hair sample with \$100 + **S&H**. We will compare the sample to the sample we have on file, then mail out the EID tag. *For this option, the animal must have been registered in its birth year.*
- You may take the animal to an ABBI-certified veterinarian between 18-34 months from the registered birth date for age verification.

EID tags may be reordered by sending in a tail hair sample with \$40 + **S&H**.
