

EID Tag Reminders

Please Note: When you receive your tags, please match up the herd number on the tag to the herd number on the animal for application. Please feel free to contact our office with any questions.

U.S. members must have a USDA Premise ID on file with us in order to receive your EID tags.

If an animal is registered in their birth year, you may purchase an EID tag at the time of registration. The EID tag will be printed with the animal's brand number, then mailed straight to you. When registering animals online, EID tags may be ordered during the checkout process. When registering animals with the paper application, EID tags may be ordered by marking "Y" for each animal in the correct column on the application.

Age certification is not required for EID tags requested at the time of birth year registration.

EID tags cost \$15 each + **shipping & handling**.

If an EID tag is not requested at the time of birth year registration, you may send in a tail hair sample with \$100 + **S&H**. We will compare the sample to the sample we have on file, then mail out the EID tag.

For animals not registered in their birth year, you may take the animal to an ABBI-certified veterinarian between 18-34 months from the registered birth date for age verification. Animals must be registered before they are taken to the vet for age verification.

EID tags may be reordered by sending in a tail hair sample with \$40 + **S&H**.
